The A465 Trunk Road (Hereford
Road, Abergavenny,
Monmouthshire) (Temporary
Traffic Prohibition & Restriction)
Order 2023

Made 24 November 2023

Coming into force 30 November 2023

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A465 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited and/or restricted because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1), (4) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A465 Trunk Road (Hereford Road, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire) (Temporary Traffic Prohibition & Restriction) Order 2023 and this Order comes into force on 30 November 2023.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means—

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

- (a) any vehicle being used for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾;
- (b) any vehicle being used for naval, military or air force purposes and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of a member of the armed forces of the Crown, who is a member of the special forces—
 - (i) in response, or for practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds;
- (c) any vehicle being used in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“special forces” (*“lluoedd arbennig”*) means those units of the armed forces the maintenance of whose capabilities is the responsibility of the Director of Special Forces or which are for the time being subject to the operational command of that Director;

“the trunk road” (*“y gefnffordd”*) means the A465 Newport to Shrewsbury trunk road;

“works period” (*“cyfnod y gwaith”*) means the period commencing at 00:01 hours on 30 November 2023 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition and restriction

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle specified in article 2(c) of this Order, on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle specified in article 2(a) and (b) of this Order, at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.

Application

5. The prohibition and restriction in articles 3 and 4 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Suspension

6. Any statutory provisions restricting the speed of vehicles on the length of the trunk road specified in Schedule 2 to this Order are suspended during such times as the restriction specified in article 4 is in operation.

Duration of this Order

7. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.

SCHEDULE 1 Temporary prohibition of vehicles

The length of the lay-by adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road, including the deceleration lane leading to and acceleration lane leading from the lay-by, located opposite the access to Roc House Farm, Hereford Road, Abergavenny, Monmouthshire.

SCHEDULE 2 Temporary 40 mph speed limit

The length of the trunk road that extends from a point 500 metres south of the centre-point of the lay-by adjacent to the northbound carriageway of the trunk road, located opposite the access to Roc House Farm, Hereford Road, Abergavenny, to a point 460 metres north of the centre-point of that lay-by.
