The A44 Trunk Road (Llanbadarn
Fawr, Ceredigion) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024

Made 1 March 2024

Coming into force 11 March 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A44 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984⁽¹⁾, make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A44 Trunk Road (Llanbadarn Fawr, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 11 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A44 Newtown to Aberystwyth trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 11 March 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction at the eastern side of the mini roundabout leading to Primrose Hill to a point 1100 metres east to its junction with the unclassified road leading to Glanyrafon Industrial Estate at Llanbadarn Fawr in the County of Ceredigion.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 18 months.
