**The A40 Trunk Road
(Glangrwyney, Powys) (Temporary
Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024**

Made 4 March 2024

Coming into force 11 March 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A40 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A40 Trunk Road (Glangrwyney, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 11 March 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the length of the A40 Raglan to Llandovery trunk road that extends from a point 100 metres east of the centre-

point of its junction with the access road leading to the property known as Cydiad-y-Ddwysir to a point 10 metres south-east of the centre-point of its junction with the side road to Dan-y-Gollen and Martell Way at Glangrwyney, south-east of Crickhowell, Powys;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 11 March 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibitions

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

4. No person may, during the works period, ride any pedal cycle on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

5. No pedestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

6. No equestrian may, during the works period, proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

7. No person may, during the works period, permit any livestock to proceed on the length of the trunk road specified in article 2 of this Order.

Application

8. The prohibitions in articles 3, 4, 5, 6 and 7 apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

9. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
