The A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd,
North of Llandybie,
Carmarthenshire) (Temporary
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order
2024

Made 3 May 2024

Coming into force 13 May 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A483 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A483 Trunk Road (Derwydd, North of Llandybie, Carmarthenshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 13 May 2024.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (*“cerbyd esempt”*) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these powers are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“y gefnffordd”) means the length of the A483 Swansea to Manchester trunk road;

“works period” (“cyfnod y gwaith”) means the period commencing at 20:00 hours on the 13 May 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the A476 at Ffairfach in a southerly direction to its junction with the U4401 unclassified road at the western side of Cilyrychen level crossing, Llandybie, Carmarthenshire.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
