**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A44 Trunk Road (Ponterwyd,  
Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition  
of Vehicles) Order 2024**

*Made* 2 September 2024

*Coming into force* 9 September 2024

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the A44 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

**Title and commencement**

1. The title of this Order is the A44 Trunk Road (Ponterwyd, Ceredigion) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2024 and this Order comes into force on 9 September 2024.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A44 Newtown to Aberystwyth trunk road;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 9 September 2024 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

**Prohibition**

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road at Ponterwyd, Ceredigion that extends from the 40 mph speed limit sign west of the George Borrow Hotel to the 30 mph speed limit sign at the eastern end of Ponterwyd, a distance of approximately 1.35 kilometres.

**Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

**Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
