**The A458 Trunk Road (Llanfair
Caereinion to Llangadfan, Powys)
(Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles)
Order 2025**

Made 6 January 2025

Coming into force 13 January 2025

The Welsh Ministers, as traffic authority for the relevant length of the A458 trunk road, are satisfied that traffic on a specified length of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), make this Order.

Title and commencement

1. The title of this Order is the A458 Trunk Road (Llanfair Caereinion to Llangadfan, Powys) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2025 and this Order comes into force on 13 January 2025.

Interpretation

2. In this Order—

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services, winter gritting vehicles or in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

By virtue of S.I. 1999/672, and section 162 of, and paragraph 30 of Schedule 11 to, the Government of Wales Act 2006 (c. 32), these functions are now exercisable by the Welsh Ministers in relation to Wales.

“the trunk road” (“y gefnffordd”) means the A458 Shrewsbury to Dolgellau Trunk Road;

“works period” (“cyfnod y gwaith”) means intermittent periods commencing at 19:00 hours on 13 January 2025 and ending when the temporary traffic signs for each period of works are permanently removed.

Prohibition

3. No person may, during the works period, drive any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, on the length of the trunk road that extends from its junction with the A495 opposite Neuadd Bridge Caravan Park, northwest of Llanfair Caereinion to its junction with the B4395, just northwest of the village of Llangadfan.

Application

4. The prohibition in article 3 applies only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

Duration of this Order

5. The maximum duration of this Order is 18 months.
